Step 1: Log into Portal

- To access the CE Portal, use your ASM credentials to login [here](#)
- On the home page, click My Credit Cart in the upper right hand corner.

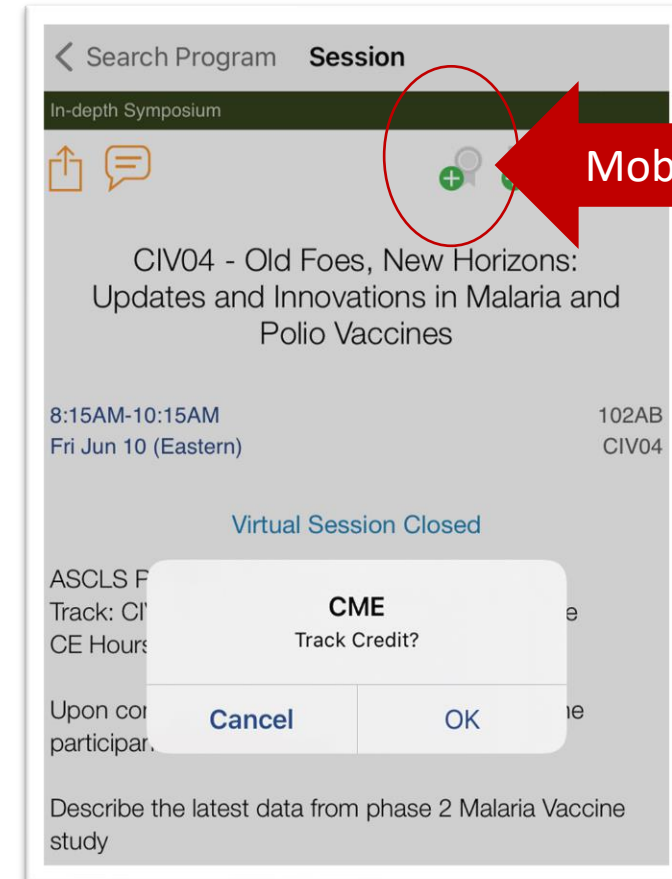

Step 3: Create Itinerary/Search Sessions

 - Search by author by adding a PLUS sign in the name (ex: John+Smith)
